Special awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

Entry requirements: Two bottles; same rules as the Drunk Monk Challenge.

Categories: Judging will be done using a combination of 2008 BJCP style guidelines (50%) and hedonistic methods (50%). Entries will be accepted in <u>only</u> the following BJCP categories:

- 18. Belgian Strong Ale
 - a) Belgian Blonde Ale
 - b) Belgian Dubbel
 - c) Belgian Tripel
 - d) Belgian Strong Golden Ale
 - e) Belgian Strong Dark Ale
- 16. Belgian & French Aleb) Belgian Pale Ale
- 5. Bock c) Doppelbock

Awards: Special awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.
