Christmas Beer Roulette

It's time to play "Christmas Beer Roulette"!

We'll do the Roulette exchange live at the Club Holiday Party at Two Brothers Roundhouse on December 20th. You still have time to brew or get something together.



Basics

Bring a 6-pack of your beer, mead, or cider to the exchange and leave with a mixed 6-pack of your fellow UKG member's brews to enjoy over the holidays. A key will be distributed after the gathering so it's not a complete mystery what 6 brews you have in your 6-pack.

The How-To Explanation

On our designated meetup day, each participant club member brings a 6-pack of all of **"one" style** of their Christmas or other Special beer, mead, or cider to the party. At check-in, you sign in and note the beverage name and description of what you brought on the sign-in sheet.

To facilitate anonymity and make this a mystery for everyone, Woj will assign your 6-pack a number and give you a note with your number so, you can claim your pack at the end once all mixed 6-packs have been created. Your bottles will also be assigned a random number and the plan is that you go home with a set of completely random bottles with none of your own and no doubles.

You share brews with fellow club members at the gathering while the packs are organized.

When all participants have checked in, we'll use a random number generation program to select brews to fill the 6-packs making sure to not include the brewers own brew in his/her pack. The more brewers we have participating, the more random the 6-packs will end up.

After all packs have been created, we each grab our 6-pack and continue to socialize.

Hopefully, you're already planning your brews for the holidays and are willing to share a 6-pack with your fellow club members.

The exchange will take place Tuesday, December 20th at our Annual UKG Club Christmas Party. If you cannot make it to the party but still want to participate, make arrangements with a fellow UKG friend to bring your beer.

If you take a trip to the Sacramento, California area, you will find not just wonderful wine, but also a thriving craft beer scene. Mike and I were there to visit our daughter, Heather and her boyfriend, Mike Zuro, whom many of you know. We were treated to some great local wine, cider, and hard kombucha while we were there, too.

Probably my favorite brewery from my visit was Heather and Mike's local watering hole, **LogOff Brewing**. The vibe there is very neighborhood pub with some regulars showing up every evening. There is plenty of indoor and outdoor seating where you



can watch the hummingbirds visit the many feeders. Inside, you find friendly staff, some pinball and board games, and many patrons with pooches in tow. No lawsuits there yet, banishing our furry friends!



The beers there were all quite good to excellent, with a strong variety. I visited in June and had the following (just to name a few):

- Walker, Texas Oranger Citrus and vanilla wheat beer (very good, great vanilla notes)
- Ume Blossom Japanese rice lager with tea and plums (excellent!)
- Hazy, Lazy Days NEIPA with Citra and Mosaic (excellent)
- Dragon Fire American Red Ale with great malt character (very good)

Mike visited in late October, and had:

- Dragon Fire (already mentioned above)
- Oktoberfest nice toasty malt character, well-balanced
- Hopsweeper West Coast DIPA Mike's a sucker for anything with Nelson Sauvin hops

In fact, I only had one beer there that I didn't love. There was a raspberry beer on tap (the name escapes me and it is not on the current tap list). The raspberry was somewhat aggressive and very candy-like.

Heather and Mike Z. were asked to guest brew there and made a Saison for the LogOff Anniversary bash. I got the privilege of naming the beer, given the rule that it HAD to be named for an 80's movie as that would be the theme for the party. Although I had to return home before the party, I did get to try the beer before they canned it..."Desperately Seeking Saison"!
